Dear Clearpoint Parents:

Earlier this week you received information from the Lester B. Pearson School Board regarding Santé Publique's plan to offer vaccinations against COVID – 19 to parents for their children aged 5 – 11. Vaccinations will be offered here at **Clearpoint Elementary on Friday, December 17.**

The memo from the LBPSB provided other details and information about how parents can book appointments to have their children vaccinated. That information is included again below:

Parents have 2 options when reserving their child's vaccination appointment:

1. Community Vaccination Sites (as of November 24)

Appointment times reserved for children will be available at all of the community vaccination sites as of November 24 (appointments required).

2. Vaccinations offered in Schools

As noted above, the date of the vaccinations for students attending Clearpoint Elementary is **Friday, December 17.**

- Please note that ONE PARENT is free to accompany their child to their appointment, specified using the links provided below (additional details about time and procedure to follow from your school).

How to make an appointment:

- There are 2 ways to make an appointment at LBPSB schools:

- Please note: If the Clic-Sante platform requires you to specify a time for your child's appointment at school, it is for planning/counting purposes only. The school will be determining the time of the vaccinations on your specified day. More specific information about vaccination times for specific grade levels and other details about how the process will work here at Clearpoint will be given to parents closer to the date of the actual vaccination.

The process, protocol and roll-out of the vaccination plan for most families in the Clearpoint Community are defined by the CIUSSS Ouest de l'île (note that for families who may live in other parts of the Greater Montreal area, the procedure may vary).
