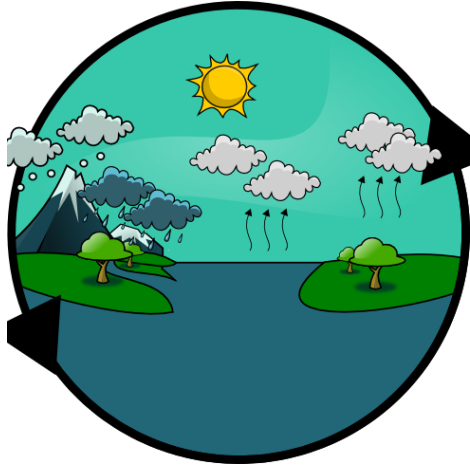


How The World Works—GRADE 1
