We have officially started our third IB unit entitled: ***Get the Dirt on Waste***. Through the study of the present unit we will be covering the **Trans-disciplinary Theme of Sharing the Planet**, where students will be inquiring about their rights and responsibilities in the struggle to share finite resources. Furthermore, we will be examining how waste needs to be managed in order to protect the environment.

Students will reflect about their consumption habits and consider their responsibility towards the planet. They will also research waste production and its impact upon the environment. The unit will focus on the **attributes** of being **caring** and **reflective**. The pupils will concentrate on the **attitudes** of **creativity** and **empathy** in their quest for viable solutions.
