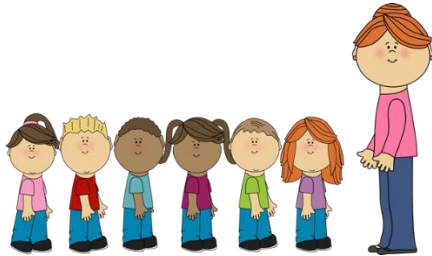




# What's happening @ Clearpoint IB

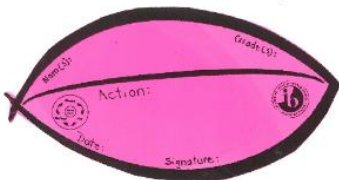
